Please remember that pupils moving into the Junior School are required to pay for school lunches (£2.30) unless they are entitled to a free school meal. If you think you may be entitled to free school meals please contact the Junior School Office in confidence. Please be aware that meals need to be paid for in advance.

If you are entitled to school meals (in the Infant or Junior Schools) and do not currently claim them, please be advised that **our schools benefit if you register for these meals regardless of whether your child takes them.** If you are in receipt of any of the following, your child may be eligible for a free school meal:

- Income Support
- Income-based Job Seeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on—paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit—if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

Snacks in the Junior School

Children in the Junior School are not provided with free snacks, they may bring a piece of fruit for morning break or they can buy fresh snacks and juice from the caterers (price list available on the last page). We do not allow chocolate bars and sweets and discourage children from bringing crisps.

PARKING

We would like to remind parents that we are unable to provide parking within the school car parks and that disabled parking bays should only be used by people with Blue Badges.
